All payments will be credited to prior balances or fines before crediting the current year. This statement does not reflect any past due amounts.

NOTE: It is the responsibility of each property owner to advise the Association of any change in his/her address or ownership.

The Association is NOT responsible for damages due to power outages. This includes food items as well as water hydrant freeze ups. The replacement of hydrants, due to freeze ups, will be billed to the property owners.
